Wednesday June 5th 1816

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the hon-
orable Alexander C. Magruder, James Shaw and Angel Maxey

Ordered that Mr Jonathan Hutton of Annapolis be appointed to go to
Calvert to receive and collect the arms belonging to the State that were sent to said
county in eighteen hundred and twelve for the draughted Militia and to have them
conveyed to the Armoury at this place.

William Dudley Digges was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court of Prince
Georges County vice Samuel Franklin resigned and Commission issued to William
Hebb, Thomas Mumdel, Joseph W. Blaggett, Henry Wareng, Robert Baden, David Cran-
ford and William Dudley Digges as Justices of the Levy Court of Prince Georges County.

William Murphy was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court of Frederick Coun-
ty vice Otto Sprigg resigned and Commission issued to Alexander Warfield of Charles
Benjamin Biggs, Stephen Steimer, James Morrison, William P. Farguhar, Joshua Gist
and William Murphy of the Sugar Loaf Mountain as Justices of the Levy Court of
Frederick County.

William Hodgkiss was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Frederick County
and a new Commission issued to said County including him.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas C. Sale
of the 2^d Regiment 500 Dollars to his pay as per account balanced and
