Levin Marshall was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Dorchester
County vice Thomas J. H. Eccleston resigned and commission issued to Joseph E. Murr
Henry Heeme of John and Levin Marshall as Justices of the Orphan Court of Dorches-
ter County.

The Council met. Present the honourable Alexander C. Mag-
awder, James Sham and Virgil Murrey.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John
hundred Dollars and seventy five cents the amount of his account as per ac-
count papered and filed.

Caleb Edmonson was appointed and commissioned coroner for Cecil County.
