Whereas by the resignation of the honorable Alexander C. Hanson a vacancy has arisen in the representation of this State in the House of Representatives of the

United States, which vacancy according to an act of Assembly passed at November

Session is contained in an act entitled "an act directing the time, place

and manner of holding elections for representatives of this State in the Congress

of the United States and for appointing electors on the part of this State for choos-

ing a President and Vice President for the United States and for the regulation

of the said elections, and also to amend the act of Assembly the words "and

passed at November Session" and the words "and five au-

thorize and command you to appoint a day to hold an election in some County

of Maryland for a Representative of this State to fill the vacancy in the House of

Representatives of the United States occasioned by the Resignation of the aforesaid

Alexander C. Hanson you are, and the said election shall be held within fifteen

days after the receipt of this warrant and you shall wear a copy thereof on each of

the Judges on each election in each of your County at least three days before the day ap-
