The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable
the Treasurer G. Haqueter Major Haxey and John Murray.

Tuesday September the 17th 1816

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the
honorable James Shaw, Major Haxey and John Murray.

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Leeds Herr Esquire
and to the estate of David Kenner to be paymaster to the 4th Regiment one hundred
and fifty four Dollars the amount of pay allowed him for paying of said Regiment
one hundred and thirteen and eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account
raped and filed.

By the Petition of John Donahoe of Somerset County accompanied by a Trans-
cript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he entered
into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty Pounds for his appearance at a public
Court to be held at the County Court house in Somerset County on the 1st of August and various
