Resolved that the Secretary of the Western Shore pay to John Leeds Barr Esquire the sum of one hundred and forty four dollars in amount of pay allowed him for paying off said Regiment one hundred and fifteen hundred and thirteen and eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

By the Petition of John Donahoe of Somerset County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty Pounds for his appearance at April Court
