ber of votes. Therefore it is hereby certified and declared that the said William
Dent Beall, Joseph Hart, Edward Johnson, John Stephen, John Buchanan,
Lawrence Bunge, George Warner, William C. Miller, Benjamin Hager, Thomas
Cornalls and Lancelot Dennis Esquires are duly elected Electors on the part of
this State to vote a President and Vice President of the United States given
in Council at the City of Annapolis since the adjournment of the State of Maryland
and this second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and sixteen and of the independence of the United States of America
