person as aforesaid voted for as Elector respectively and should thereupon declare
by Proclamation signed by the Governor, and without delay dispose through-
out the State the name of the person or persons duly elected as Elector in each respec-
tive District. We in pursuance of the directions of the said act do by this our Pro-
clamation declare that by the returns made to us it appears that William
DeWitt Esquire was elected for the first District Joseph Hunt Esquire was elect-
ed for the second District Edward Johnson and John Stephen Esquires were elect-
ed for the third District John Buchanan and Lawrence Burleigh Esquires were
elected for the fourth District George W. Moore Esquire was elected for the fifth District
William C. Miller Esquire was elected for the sixth District Benjamin Hapoy Esquire
was elected for the seventh District Thomas Corwells Esquire was elected for the eighth
District and Titilian Dennis Esquire was elected for the ninth District. Given in
