The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable
William Potter, Henry H. Chapman, Richard Frisby and James Shaw.

George Plateau and Thomas Spalding Junior were appointed Justices of the Peace
for Saint Marys County and a new commission issued to said County including them.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Ensign Elisha Berry of the
2^d Regiment nine Dollars and sixty cents the amount of pay due him for services on
July eighteen hundred and fourteen omitted in Captain Belmeers pay Roll as per
account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Water
Brigade Quarter Master at Baltimore two hundred and forty Dollars the amount of
his account for storage of Military goods and salary up to the eighth of January
