Alembry Jump, Richard Hughtlett and James Houston were appointed Justices of The Orphans Court for Caroline County and Commission issued accordingly.

Ordered that Colonel Richard Waters forward to the State Armours at Annapolis all the Public and military stores now in his care and possession and that the functions and duties of his office as agent do henceforth cease.

Friday January the 10th 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Willm Potter, Henry H. Chapman, Richard Fairby and James Shaw.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Munroe Esquire nine Dollars and forty seven cents for postage as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Davis fifteen Dollars fifty^{cts} East employed in the Militia of the 21st Regiment in Kent County as per account papered and filed.
