of the Peace for Talbot County and commission issued accordingly.

Nathan Hamington, Freeborn Banning, Rayton A. Skinner, John Stevens Junior,  
James Seth, Thomas Hayward and Allen Bowie were appointed Justices of the Levy  
Court of Talbot County and commission issued accordingly.

William Thomas, Nicholas Goldsborough and Tench Tilghman were appointed  
Justices of the Orphans Court for Talbot County and commission issued accordingly.

Nicholas Loverday was appointed Coroner for Talbot County and commission  
issued to him accordingly.

Monday January the 20<sup>th</sup> 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable  
William Potter, Henry H. Chapman, James Shaw and William H. Ward.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Conrad Shafer one hundred and  
eleven Dollars and fifty five cents for supplies furnished the drafted Militia under the  
command of Captains Ogle Boashear and Smith on their march to Baltimore in May  
eighteen hundred and thirteen as per account paid and filed.
