The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable
Henry H. Chapman, Richard Fairby and James Shaw.

John Donovan of Dorchester County was appointed trustee to make sale of Lot No 9.
of the Choptank Indian Lands Bond to be given with a penalty of 3000 Dollars on a
credit of one year.

Nicholas W. Brice was appointed Chief Justice and William M. Mechin and Ab-
ander Nesbitt associate Judges of Baltimore City Court and commission issued to them
accordingly.

Charles W. Hanson was appointed an associate Judge for the 6th Judicial District and
Hebuton Hollingsworth removed and commission issued accordingly.

Jonathan Meredith, Thomas Hill and David Hoffman were appointed Commissioners
of Insolvency for Baltimore.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Marshall acting
Surgeon to the 19th Regiment twenty eight Dollars and forty Cents for his pay
for services performed in July and August eighteen hundred and fourteen, as per ac-
count papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of The Western Shore pay to W. W. Dummer
to the credit of the Western Shore Debtors and the balance of the account
