

alter and every part of the constitution and form of government as relates to the Attorney General; and an act to alter and change such parts of the constitution and form of government as relate to the division of Anne Arundel County in election districts; and to change the place of holding elections in the second election District of said County; be published once in each week, for the space of three months, in the Maryland Gazette The Federal Gazette and Federal Republican at Baltimore, The Frederick Town Herald, The Torch light at Hagerstown, The Allegany Federalist and The Monitor at Easton

Ordered that three copies of Hiltop compilation of the British statutes be forwarded with the laws to each of the Counties in this state and two copies to the clerk of the court of Appeals for the Eastern Shore, and ~~in~~ the Western Shore

Ordered that three hundred Dollars are hereby appropriated for the purpose of forwarding the laws of the last General Assembly and Public Packages to the several Counties on the Western Shore and two hundred Dollars for forwarding them to the several Counties on the Eastern Shore.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore to G. J. Guommoe sixty Dollars and five cents for his services and expences in riding express to Baltimore and Caroline as per account papered and filed.
