

By the Petition of John M'Curdy of the City of Baltimore accompanied by a Transcript of the Proceedings of the late Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery for Baltimore County it appears that he was fined by the said Court at January term eighteen hundred and seventeen in three cases the sum of twenty Dollars in each case for selling spirituous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states that having in the vacation of the said Court purchased a House in the City of Baltimore which had been heretofore kept as a Tavern and having obtained a licence from the United States and made the necessary arrangements to keep a commodious and orderly house he was only waiting for the Session of the said Court to obtain a licence for an ordinary in this interval he had permitted a person to board in his family whom it appears the said Petitioner's wife supplied in a few instances with liquor at his meals. That as soon as the Court commenced its Session in January last he applied for and obtained a licence for a Tavern which he now keeps. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the said Court do remit the said fines.

By the Petition of Greenbury L. That the proposed scheme of a lottery was for the purpose of disposing an inconsiderable stock of Merchandize which he then held.
