

Monday April the 7<sup>th</sup> 1817

The Council met. present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable, Gen,  
H. Chapman, Richard Inisby and James Shaw.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Elisha Brown a Captain  
in the thirty second Regiment twenty seven Dollars and sixty six and two thirds Cents  
it being the amount of pay due him for services in August and September eighteen hundred  
and fourteen and allowed in pursuance of a resolution of the General Assembly  
passed at December session eighteen hundred and sixteen.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Johnson five Dollars  
and sixty Cents it being the amount paid by him on account of Sheriffs fees for  
Joseph Capelman charged with horse stealing

Thomas Marshall was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at Piles Warehouse in Charles  
County and commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Buckmaster  
forty Dollars for the use of his House for the reception of arms as per account passed and  
filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Edelin three Dollars  
and fifty Cents for militia expences as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward R. Gibson twelve Dollars  
and sixty Cents for whiskey furnished the Militia as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Clogell  
Master to the 17<sup>th</sup> Regiment sixty nine Dollars and nineteen Cents for pay and  
services as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to
