Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George and John Barber three Dollars and ninety five and an half cents for freight of United States Laws from Alexandria as per account passed and filed.

Thursday June 12<sup>th</sup> 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable William Potter, Henry H. Chapman and James Shaw.

General Joseph Storrell was appointed Notary Public for the State of Maryland John Stuart deceased to reside in the City of Baltimore in Baltimore County and commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw one thousand and twenty six Dollars and eighty six and one quarter Cents the amount of his account for the purchase of the Laws of the United States, binding Cham Proceedings &c as per account passed and filed.

On the application of William Stewart of the City of Baltimore in the amount of two hundred and twenty five Dollars and one quarter Cents for his services in the purchase of the Laws of the United States.
