

and 399 on the East side of Jones Falls in the City of Baltimore contained within the following description. Beginning for the same on the North west side of York Street at the distance of forty feet North Easterly from the corner formed by the intersection of the North west side of York Street and the North East side of Granby Street and running thence North ~~east~~ Easterly bounding on York Street eighty feet, thence Northwesterly parallel with Granby Street one hundred feet, thence Southwesterly parallel with York Street eighty feet, thence South Easterly by a straight line to the place of beginning which are said to be liable to confiscation. The Board agreed to sell the States Rights to said Lots for one thousand eight hundred and fifty Dollars on the payment of the said sum into the Treasury or on the said Streets giving Bond with approved security.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Shaw five hundred and sixty one Dollars and fifty cents the amount of his salary as Assessor and for other charges exhibited in his account and that the salary of the said Assessor for the residue of the year commencing on the first Instant shall be at the rate of five hundred Dollars per Annum for which sum it is expected all services hitherto rendered as Assessor will be hereafter performed.

Ordered that the State House and its appendages be committed to John Shaw for the preservation of the same and that he be allowed at the rate of fifty Dollars per annum as a compensation for his services in discharge of this order.

John C. Hull and Adam Whamra were appointed Notaries Public for the State of Maryland to reside at Elkton in Cecil County and commission issued to them accordingly.
