Tuesday June the 13th 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honourable Mr. William Pollock, Henry H. Chapman, James Shaw and Richard Frisby.

John Goldsborough Esquire was appointed agent for the year eighteen hundred and seventeen to collect the debts and balances due the State.

Colonel Richard Waters was appointed agent to collect the Public Arms in the district composed of Baltimore and Harford Counties and the City of Baltimore.

Alamy Jump was appointed Agent to collect the Public Arms in the District composed of the Eastern Shore Counties.

Benjamin Pindell was appointed Agent to collect the Public Arms in the District composed of the city of Annapolis, Saint Marys, Charles, Montgomery, Prince Georges, Calvert and Anne Arundel Counties.

Henry Heyman was appointed to collect the Public Arms in the District composed of Frederick Washington and Allegany Counties.
