

such advances of money will be made you from time to time as your exigencies and necessities may render necessary. You are directed to call on the Lieutenant Colonels of the several Regiments and Majors commanding Extra Battalions in your district and to request of them such aid as they may be enabled to afford you in the discharge of your duty. In all cases where Captains commanding companies may be desirous of retaining their arms you are fully authorized to suffer them to remain in their possession provided the Captain of such companies shall give approved Bonds for the safe return of such arms when required.
