Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Gotlieb J. Grossman two hundred and forty eight Dollars and ninety five cents for his expences and allowance for bringing from the State of Delaware Negro George a fugitive from Justice of this State and lodging him in Caroline County Jail
