Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the legal representatives of the late Hodgkin late Lieutenant and Colonel of the 31st Regiment fifty Dollars and fifty cents for pay due him for services in April eighteen hundred and thirteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Fielder Ridgeway twenty eight Dollars for taking care of the Public Arms &c. as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marsham Parker one hundred and eighty five Dollars and seventeen cents in full of his claims as Contractor and Quarter Master as per account papered and filed.

Pursuant to the appointment and direction of the honourable the Governor and Council of Maryland to sell Lot No 9 of the Choptank Indian Lands in Dorchester County, I gave public notice in several parts of the County; in the Monitor and Eastern Star published at Easton, that said Lot would be sold on a credit of twelve months on the 1st of March last, and on that day at Public Auction Roger Hooper became the purchaser in and for the two thousand three hundred Dollars and entered into Bond with two securities, a duplicate of which is enclosed, which I hope will meet the approbation of the Governor and Council. The Original is in my possession subject to their direction.
