Monday September the 22^d 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Henry H. Chapman, Richard Faisby, James Shaw and William H. Ward.

William H. Mahon was appointed Clerk of Allegany County Court until the meeting of the said Court and commission issued to him accordingly, vice H. Briscoe dead.

Tuesday September the 23^d 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Henry H. Chapman, Richard Faisby, James Shaw and William H. Ward.

Charles Croxall was appointed Coroner for the City of Baltimore in the room of George W. Betts deceased and commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that The Treasurer of The Western Shore pay to Hill Peck one hundred and seven Dollars and sixty nine and an half cents for breakfasts furnished the Militia under the command of Captain Samuel Ogle on their march to Baltimore in April eight hundred and thirteen as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that The Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Hain thousand and ten Dollars and fifty cents for cleaning Muskets & salary as Agent for collection of the Public Arms as per account passed and filed.

By the Petition of Francis Dancy accompanied by a Transcript from the Court of the Court of Prince Georges County it appears that he was secured for a certain Cannoll for a fine of sixteen Dollars that had been levied on him by the Court of
