Wednesday September the 26 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Henry
H. Chapman, Richard Friesby, James Shaw and William H. Ward.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Shaw five hundred and
forty five Dollars for repairs done to the State House as per account papered and filed.

From Thursday September the 25 To Thursday October the 9 1817 The honourable
Henry H. Chapman and James Shaw appeared on the Council room

Friday October the 10 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and the honourable Henry
H. Chapman, Richard Friesby, James Shaw and William H. Ward.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Butler forty nine
Dollars and forty three Cents for his allowance and expences in going for John Lacy a
fugitive from justice.

Benjamin Tippett was appointed Surveyor for Saint Marys County vice Joseph Dunn
resigned and commission issued to him accordingly.

James Holland was appointed Reporter of the Council.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Crane one hundred
four Dollars and eighty Cents in addition to former allowance as per account papered and
for purchasing supplies for the Militia of Kent County in April and May eighteen
and Thirteen.
