Wednesday September the 24 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Henry  
H. Chapman, Richard Frisby, James Shaw and William H. Ward.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Shaw five hundred and  
forty five Dollars for repairs done to the State House as per account papered and filed.

Friday October the 10 1817

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Henry  
H. Chapman, Richard Frisby, James Shaw and William H. Ward.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Butler forty nine  
Dollars and forty three cents for his allowance and expences in going for John Lacy a  
fugitive from justice.

Benjamin Tippet was appointed Surveyor for Saint Marys County vice Joseph Dene  
resigned and commission issued to him accordingly.

James Holland was appointed Meperiger of the Council.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Crane one hundred and  
four Dollars and eighty cents in addition to former allowance as per account papered and filed  
for purchasing supplies for the Militia of Kent County in April and May eighteen hundred  
and thirteen.
