Perches to a white oak tree the beginning of Good or Bad then North  
ten degrees and a quarter east seven Perches and three tenths to a stone  
set on the east or home line of a tract of land called Successor, thence  
along said line and bounded by the same south forty six degrees and a  
quarter East three hundred and twelve Perches to the west bank of  
Big Elk Creek or river thence down the same and bounded thereon south  
eleven degrees west sixty four Perches and from thence by a direct line  
bounding on said river to the place of Beginning. The Council agree  
to sell the States right to said land to the said Thompson Randolph for  
the sum of one hundred and eighty two Dollars on a credit of three years.
