Ordered that the foregoing Proclamation be published in the Maryland Gazette, Federal Republican Federal Gazette Frederick Town Herald the Torch Light, Allegany Federalist and Easton Gazette once a week for the space of ten weeks.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Cole, Sheriff of Saint Marys County, three hundred and fifty nine dollars and forty five cents for his expences and so forth incurred in bringing from Saint Marys County to Baltimore Negroes Harry, Jack, Abraham, Joe and John whose sentence of death had been commuted by his Excellency the Governor on the seventeenth of June last to transportation as per account passed and filed.

Saturday January the 3rd 1818

The council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable Daniel Murray, John Hoops, John Eager Howard Junior, Henry A. Ballis and Arnold E. Jones.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George W. Biscoe thirty five dollars for rations for himself and servant for thirty five days services in Prince Georges and Charles Counties in eighteen hundred and thirtean and fourteen as per account passed.

Monday, January the 5th 1818

The council met present His Excellency the Governor and the Honble Daniel Murray, John Hoops, John Eager Howard Junior Henry A. Ballis and Arnold E. Jones.

James Mackubin Horatio Kidout and Lewis Beth Junior were appointed Justices of the Orphans Court for Anne Arundel County and commission issued to them accord.
