The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Talbot County, Greeting,
Whereas a certain William Nelson, has been indicted at a court of General Quarter sessions of the Peace, and Goal Delivery of the State of Delaware, begun and held at Newcastle, in and for Newcastle County, in December last, of the crime of Kidnapping, an authentic copy of which indictment has been transmitted to me by the Governor of the State of Delaware. And Whereas it has been represented to me, by His Excellency John Clarke, Governor of the said State of Delaware, that the said William Nelson hath fled from the said State from Justice into the State of Maryland; the said John Clarke hath in pursuance of the Constitution of the United States and the act of Congress entitled "An act respecting fugitives from Justice, and persons escaping from the service of their masters," demanded of me the said William Nelson, as a fugitive from Justice, and that he be delivered to Henry M Godwin, the agent appointed to receive him. You are therefore hereby commanded to take the body of the said William Nelson, if he shall be found in your Bailwick, and him safe keep, so that you have him ready to be delivered up to the said Henry M Godwin to be removed to the State of Delaware; there to answer the charge exhibited against him, and how you shall execute this writ you shall notify me with all convenient despatch.
