Joseph Twilley was appointed adjutant to the eleventh Regiment Maryland Militia in Dorchester County vice Clement Stanford resigned.

By the Petition of John Barber of Montgomery County accompanied by a transcript from the proceedings of the court of the said County, it appears that he was fined by the said court, at November Term last, in six cases for selling spirituous liquor without licence the sum of six pounds current money in each case. The Petitioner states that the Husband of his sister had a licence to retail spirituous liquors, and that he died before the licence expired.
