Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be and he is hereby authorized to sell to the President and Directors of the marine Bank of Baltimore the unsubscribed shares reserved to the State in the Stock of that Bank at ten per cent advance agreeably to their proposition.

Ordered, that the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to sell to the President and Directors of the Union Bank of Maryland on the same terms if offered the unsubscribed Shares reserved to the State in the Stock of said Bank and if the President and Directors do not agree to take said shares at ten per cent advance he is in that event directed to advertise said Stock for sale.

Ordered, that if a sale cannot be effected on the Terms required by law, the Treasurer is authorized to negotiate a loan for a sum not exceeding fifty thousand dollars agreeably to the resolution of the General Assembly passed on the thirteenth of February. . . . No 48.

John Cameron of Cecil county was appointed Inspector of salted fish at the head of the Bay.

Ordered, that the Clerk of the Council send a Letter to the agents on the Western Shore for the collection of the public arms as follows.

Sir, When the Council appointed the agents for the collection of the Public Arms they probably considered that the expences of collection transportation and so forth would require that money should be placed in the hands of the Agents which was accordingly done. Your account to this Department specifies that Stand of arms are collected at different places, the necessary and personal expences of their collection amounting to Your charge of per diem allowance cannot be considered.
