

Tuesday September the 22nd 1818

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honble
Daniel Murray, John Slope, Henry Aballas and Arnold T. Jones.

In consequence of a communication laid before the Board by His
Excellency, the Governor from the Honble John L Ken agent for militia
claims, informing the Executive that forty thousand dollars were
placed by the Honble Secretary of war subject to the order of the Executive
on the Treasury of the United States, in part payment of the State's
claim on the general Government for militia expenditures during
the late war the following order was issued.

In Council September the 22 1818

The Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland is hereby authorised
and directed to receive from the United States the sum of forty
thousand dollars, being in part payment of the State of Maryland's
claim against the United States, per act December session 1816 chap. 101

John Bishop was appointed coroner for Worcester County and
Commission issued to him accordingly.

Thomas Hodges was appointed Notary Public for the State
of Maryland to reside at Upper Marlborough in Prince Georges
County in the said State, and commission issued to him.

Walter Slicer was appointed Captain George Shook Lieutenant
and John Oglebay Ensign of a Uniform Company in the fifteenth
Regiment of the Militia of this State in Allegany County.

By the Motion of John Lindsay, Richard Piles and George Summers,
accompanied by a Transcripe from the Proceedings of Prince Georges
County Court, it appears that John Lindsay was recognized in
the sum of one hundred dollars and Richard Piles and George Summers
his two securities in the sum of fifty dollars each, for the appearance
of the said Lindsay at the said Court at March Term eighteen
hundred and seventeen to answer for an assault and Battery.
