

to receive the said David Blabaugh and to remove him to the said Commonwealth having jurisdiction of the offence with which he is charged. I have therefore thought proper in pursuance of the said Constitution and Act of Congress to order and direct, that you deliver the said David Blabaugh to the said Samuel Galloway to be removed to the said Commonwealth, provided the said David Blabaugh has not been committed to the said Jail on a charge of having violated any of the laws of this State.
