The Council met (present his Excellency the Governor and the Hon Daniel Murray, John Stoops, John Eager Howard Jun^r, Henry A Callis and Arnold E Jones.

John Wilson was appointed Pay Master to the twenty seventh Regiment of the militia of this State in the city of Baltimore. David W Duncan was appointed Captain and John W Duncan first Lieutenant of an artillery company in the second Artillery Regiment attached to the fourteenth Brigade of the Militia of this State in the city of Baltimore.

John Schwartzer was appointed third Lieutenant of Captain Russells Artillery Company in the second Artillery Regiment attached to the fourteenth Brigade of the militia of this State.

Benedict H Hanson was appointed Adjutant Thomas H Bond Quarter Master, Walden G Middleton Pay Master and William P Herbert Surgeons mate of the forty second Regiment of the militia of this State in Harford County.
