

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John G. Claaves Paymaster to the thirty fifth Regiment one hundred and twenty dollars for paying off said Regiment to this date as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Alexander Graham one hundred and ninety nine dollars and seventy five cents for publishing sundry laws &c as per account passed.

The account of Stephen Rumell for riding express to the Hon^{ble} Henry A. Ballis on the twentieth of October last was passed for ten dollars.

The account of James Munroe for postages was passed for forty seven dollars and sixty two and a half cents.

Ordered that the account of John Brewer Esquire Register of the Land office for the Western Shore, for making a General Index of Land Titles agreeably to the act of Assembly of February the fifth eighteen hundred and seventeen, be settled on the Terms offered to the Executive by his letter of march the Eleventh eighteen hundred and seventeen to wit that he be allowed the sum of twenty three hundred and seventy five dollars together with the price of the books in which the Index is made. Therefore Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the said John Brewer the sum of two hundred and seventy five dollars it being the balance due him after deducting twenty one hundred dollars that had been advanced to him at different periods to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Accounts of the Agents for the Collection of the public Arms, be settled by the Clerk of the Council on the Agents producing the Armourers receipts for the delivery of the Arms actually collected by them at the following rates, it being understood expressly with the said Agents that the expense of collecting and transporting said Arms is to be borne by them exclusively, and that the said rates are not to apply to arms collected in the City of Baltimore.
