

Saturday, December 12th 1818

The Council met present His Excellency, the Governor and the Honourable Daniel Murray, John E. Howard Junior and Henry A. Baltis.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isaac Bradley, five hundred and thirty six dollars and twenty five cents, for altering the fire places in the Senate Chamber, and the House of Delegates Room, as per account passed and filed with the Auditor General.

John Glenn was appointed Adjutant to the fifty second Regiment of the militia of this State in the City of Baltimore.

The Account of Gueves and Herberts for printing in Hagers Town was passed for six dollars and paid.

The account of Joseph Smith for publishing Proclamations was passed for twenty eight dollars and twenty five cents.

The account of Rummells & Matthews for riding express was passed for ten dollars and paid.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Shuckles and James Korman two hundred dollars for apprehending Obed Griffith, accused of committing a murder in Baltimore County and delivering him to the Sheriff of Baltimore County.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Hon.^{ble} Luther Martin, three hundred dollars, for legal services in the case of John Chandler against the State of Maryland in Baltimore County Court and for other legal services.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Maynader, Jeremiah Hughes and Francis Hollingsworth seven hundred and five dollars and five cents the balance of their accounts for improving the public circle, as per accounts passed and filed.
