By the Petition of William Parish, of the City, of Annapolis, accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of Anne Arundel County Court, it appears that he was fined by the said Court at September Term last in three cases, the sum of six pounds current money in each case, for selling spirituous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states, that at the time he committed the said offences, he was ignorant that it was necessary to have a licence as a Retailer, being under the impression that the necessity of having one was removed by the repeal of the internal taxes by the Congress of the United States. That he has a large family of children to support, with no other resource than his own personal labour, which is scarcely sufficient for that purpose, and should he not be released by executive interference, from the payment of the fines, he will suffer great distress. The Board, on consideration of which circumstance, and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County, and a number of respectable persons do remit the said three fines.
