Ordered that the account of W. John Brewer, Register of the Land Office for making a general Index under act of Assembly authorising the Governor and Council to contract with the Registers of the Land Offices for making Indexes &c be reconsidered, and that he be allowed the sum claimed in his account to wit, twelve and a half cents for each entry deducting one hundred and nineteen dollars and thirty seven and a half cents for stationary previously paid for by the Council and leaving a balance in favor of Mr. Brewer of two hundred and ninety two dollars and sixty two and a half cents. order issued on the Treasurer accordingly.

Henry Maynadier Murray was appointed District Attorney for the sixth Judicial District of Baltimore and Harford Counties in the room of Samuel Livermore Esquire resigned, and Commission issued to him accordingly.

The Council met present His Excellency the Governor and the Hon^{ble} John E. Howard Junr., Henry H Chapman, Henry A Callis, Arnold E Jones and John Stoops.

George Barningham, Vachel Burgess, Benjamin Hart, John Croxall, John Edmondson, William Monker, Alexander Turner and Samuel Yonner were appointed wood corders for Baltimore.

Thomas Barnett, Nicholas Burke, James King, George Hall, Peter Fowble, Wesley Starr, James Norris and Samuel Simmons were appointed Inspectors of Lumber for Baltimore County & City.

John A Bowland, was appointed Surveyor of Somerset County in the place of Beauchamp Achworth resigned, and Commission issued to him accordingly.
