and Commission issued to them accordingly.

The Council met present His Excellency the Governor and the
Hon^{ble} John Eager Howard Junr, Henry H. Chapman, Henry
A. Callis and John Sloops.

By the Petition of William Stump of Henry accompanied by a
Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Harford County it
appears that he was fined by the said Court at August Term
eighteen hundred and eighteen the sum of five hundred dollars for
assaulting Harman Stump. And it appearing to the Board from
respectable authority, that testimony adduced to them calculated to
extenuate the offence on the part of the said William Stump was
not produced before the Court at the trial, and the said William
Stump's Petition being accompanied by a Recommendation of many
respectable persons some of whom solicit a remission of the whole and
others a part of the said fine the Board thereupon have remitted three
hundred dollars of the fine aforesaid.
