Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs Gruber and May printers at Hagers Town three dollars and fifty cents for publishing a Proclamation of Governor Ridgely recommending a day of thanksgiving as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Gwynn Editor of the Federal Gazette three hundred and ninety six dollars and fifty cents for publishing a List of Lottery Laws, by order of the commissioners, also the Law respecting Negroes, and mulattoes and other printing ordered by the Legislature and twenty six dollars for printing Executive business as per accounts passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Preston one hundred and thirty eight dollars for his Expenses and allowance in bringing David Foulk a fugitive from justice from the State of Pennsylvania and delivering him into Harford County jail.

Executive communication made to the honorable the House of Delegates shewing the number of arms, Accoutrements &c. their situation and condition as far as practicable.

A copy of a Law passed during the present session entitled "An Act incorporating a company to erect a Toll bridge across the Potomac River opposite Shepherds Town was transmitted to the governor of Virginia.
