A new commission of Justices of the Peace for Saint Marys County was directed in which Thomas B. Bridcoe was inserted on his reappointment of this date.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw one hundred and seventy eight dollars and ninety three cents for Paper &c furnished for the use of the Executive Department as per account passed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert Spedden seventy five dollars for one quarters salary as Armourer at Boston.
