

Ordered, that the act, Entitled, "An act to relieve the people of this State as far as practicable from the evils arising from the demands made on the Banks of this State for gold and silver by Brokers and to prohibit the officers of the different Banks from buying and selling Bank notes of the Banks of this State at a less price than their nominal value," be published once in the Maryland Gazette, the Federal Gazette, the Easton Gazette and the Allegany paper.

Ordered that the act passed at the last session of the General Assembly Entitled "An act to establish a new Election District in Baltimore County" be published for the period of six weeks in the Federal Republican, the American and Maryland Gazette.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr James Holland, the sum of ten dollars and sixty four and a half cents, it being the amount paid by him for sweeping chimneys of the Stad House as per account passed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Munroe Post Master at Annapolis, for postages for the Executive Department and the Treasurer, sixty eight dollars and fifty five and a half cents as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Shaw one hundred and twenty dollars and fifty six and a half cents for Salary as Armourer at Annapolis as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr John Shaw seventy eight dollars and thirty seven cents, the balance due him on a former account, for repairs to the Stad House as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Green one hundred and seven dollars and twelve and a half cents for printing &c.
