Satisfactory evidence having been exhibited to me, that William R Swift, is appointed Consul of his most faithful Majesty, the King of the United Kingdom of Portugal, Brazil and Algarves, for the State of Maryland, I do hereby recognize him as such, and declare him free to exercise and enjoy such functions powers and privileges as are allowed to Consuls of the most favoured Nations in the United States. In Testimony whereof I have caused these letters to be made patent, and the seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington this second day of March Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, and of the Independence of the United States of America the forty third.
