Ordered, that the Treasurer of the (Western Shore) pay to Alonby Jump Esquire, Agent for the collection of the public Arms, two thousand and eighty seven dollars and thirty seven and a half cents, the balance of his account for collecting and delivering to the Armouries at Easton two thousand one hundred and fifty nine muskets, sixteen Cannon, two thousand and fifty seven cartouch Boxes, one hundred and six pair of Pistols and Holsters, fifty rifles and fifty cartouch Boxes, and two hundred and thirteen swords as per account filed.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor the following appointments were made.

Young Dossey, James John Pattison and William Clare Justices of the Levy Court for Calvert County in place of Sutton Isaac Weems, and John G Maekall refusing to act and Michael Toney moved away.

John T Baden, Inspector of Tobacco at Nottingham Warehouse in Prince Georges County in the place of Aquila Beale resigned.

Resolved as above, in the case of an application from Charles County for a demand by this Executive of the Executive of Virginia for a delivery of Mitchell Allen a fugi-

time from justice, on being in Charles County Jail, and that the same be referred to His Excellency the Governor, and the Honourable Henry A Chapman, and that their decision on the said subject be concurred in and approved by this Board.
