By the Petition of James L Neale, accompanied by a transcript
from the proceedings of the Court of Charles County it appears that he was
fined by the said Court at August Term eighteen hundred and seventeen
in six cases the sum of six pounds current money in each case for selling
liquors without licence. And it appearing further from the certificate
of Francis Digges Esquire, one of the justices of the Orphans Court of said
county, that the said James L Neale applied to him in October eighteen
hundred and sixteen for leave to retail spirituous liquors observing at
the same time that he had violated the law by selling spirituous liquor
without a permit and that the same was done through ignorance and not
design. And the Honourable the Chief and the two associate Judges of the
said Court having recommended a remission of the said fines, it is
ordered that the said James L Neale be released from the said fines
amounting to ninety six dollars.
