

Ordered, by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Gausson ten dollars for one quarters pension due him the first of May last. allowed by a Resolution of the General Assembly passed at a November Session seventeen hundred & ninety one.

Ordered, by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Anderson, sixty dollars for one quarters half pay due him the first of May last under the provisions of the act of Assembly, passed at a November Session seventeen hundred & eighty five entitled, "An act for the relief of certain maimed & disabled officers."

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Shaw three hundred and twenty six dollars for salary as armorer at Annapolis &c as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Clerk of the Council direct the Armorer at Easton and the Armorer at Annapolis not to send any more powder to Baltimore.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jehu Chandler twenty dollars and fifty cents for printing for the Auditor and Treasurer as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Green Esquire, appointed to print the Laws now compiling, by the Chancellor Thomas Harris and John A. Watkins Esquires, one thousand dollars to be by him accounted for on a final settlement of his account.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw Esquire one hundred and thirteen dollars and eighty eight cents, for paper &c furnished for the Executive as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Richard Ireland Jones five dollars for transmitting laws to Centreville as per account.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs. Wells two dollars and fifty cents, for the hire of her Negro Man employed in cutting poplar Trees before the State House as per account passed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Robert Spedden seventy five dollars for one quarters salary as Armorer at Easton due the first day of May last.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs. Gales and Seaton ten dollars for one years subscription for the National Intelligencer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs. George & John Danion, one dollar & twenty five cents for freight on laws to Easton &c from down.
