

Murphy and Bose, Editors of the American, out of any money which may be in the Treasury arising from Lotteries and from no other funds, one hundred and fifty three dollars and fifty cents it being the amount of their account for printing and for one pair of Lottery wheels, cases stands &c furnished the Lottery commissioners as per account.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs Edes & Editors of the Federal Republican and Baltimore Telegraph, out of any money which may be in the Treasury arising from Lotteries and from no other funds, four dollars and fifty cents, for advertising notice of meeting of Lottery commissioners, notice of Lotteries and for a clerk as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Elizabeth Fitzhugh, out of any money which may be in the Treasury arising from Lotteries and from no other funds one hundred and eighty seven dollars and fifty cents for nine months rent of office for Lottery commissioners as per account.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr John Davis thirteen dollars and seventy five cents, out of any money which may be in the Treasury arising from Lotteries and from no other funds, for one sheet iron sander fixing Lock on Lottery wheels, gilding and painting the glasses as per account passed & filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward Steele, Esquire out of any money which may be in the Treasury arising from Lotteries and from no other funds eighty nine dollars and fifty cents for stationery furnished for the use of the Lottery commissioners as per account passed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to G Hubball, out of any money which may be in the Treasury arising from Lotteries and from no other funds three dollars for shovel and Tongs furnished for the use of the officer of the Lottery commissioners as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Anthony Law, out of any money which may be in Treasury arising from Lotteries and from no other funds, forty one dollars and twenty five cents for three writing tables furnished for the use of the Lottery Commissioners as per account.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western shore pay Robert Welch of Ben, the sum of three hundred dollars for forwarding Laws and Votes and Proceedings December session eighteen hundred and eighteen to the several Comices on the west
