The State of Maryland to wit. Whereas a demand has been made by the Executive of the Commonwealth of Virginia upon the Executive of the State of Maryland, in conformity to the act of Congress of the United States in such case made and provided, that a certain Jesse McCoy charged on the affidavit of a certain Lewis Bell, made before Daniel Carmichael Esquire, a Justice of the Peace for Westmoreland County in the said Commonwealth, with having committed a felony within the County and Commonwealth aforesaid in stealing and carrying away a Boatman, the property of a certain John Stewart and supposed to have fled from the Commonwealth of Virginia to the State of Maryland, be delivered up as a fugitive from justice; and whereas His Excellency James P. Preston Governor of the said Commonwealth of Virginia, hath transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, the affidavit duly authenticated, of the said Lewis Bell, charging the said Jesse McCoy as aforesaid and hath also notified to this Department the appointment of a certain Lewis Bell, as agent to receive the said Jesse McCoy, and convey him to the said Commonwealth of Virginia; And whereas the said Jesse McCoy is now in confinement in the jail of Anne Arundel County, in the City of Annapolis; and the said Lewis Bell hath this day appeared, and presented to this Department, the Letters patent of the said Commonwealth of Virginia authenticated by the signature of the Governor of the said Commonwealth and by the Great Seal thereof appointing him the Agent of the said Commonwealth for the purposes aforesaid. Now therefore, I Charles Goldsborough, Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought proper to issue this order hereby authorizing and requiring you to deliver the
