To the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County.

The State of Maryland, To all whom it may concern. Whereas a certain Jesse McCoy, lately a prisoner in Anne Arundel County Gaol, being charged with the commission of a felony in the Commonwealth of Virginia, and being demanded by the Executive of the said Commonwealth, under the laws of the Congress of the United States, as a fugitive from justice of the said Commonwealth to the State of Maryland hath this day been delivered to the custody of Lewis Bell, an agent duly appointed by the Executive of the said Commonwealth of Virginia to receive the said fugitive and convey him to the said Commonwealth for trial according to law; Now therefore all persons within the State of Maryland are hereby required and enjoined to let the said Lewis Bell pass with his said prisoner, unmolested to Virginia; let the said Lewis Bell demeaning himself in a peaceable and orderly manner, and using no improper severity or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner, beyond what is necessary, and proper for his safe custody.
