The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Hon^{ble}
John E. Howard Junior, Henry A. Chapman and Henry A. Ballis.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r John
Shaw, the sum of twenty six dollars and forty cents the amount of his
account for paper cases for the Executive Department as per account.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Buck and
Hendrick's one hundred and thirty seven dollars and fifty cents for a flag
for the State as per accounts passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mess^{rs} Scales
and Heath nine dollars for the Federal Republican for 1819.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Wells
the sum of thirty dollars for six months rent of Magazine due the twelfth
of October last as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Shaw one
hundred and sixty two dollars and fifty cents for one quarters Salary as
Armourer at Annapolis &c. as per account passed and filed.
