Thursday December 9th 1819

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Hon^{ble} John Eager Howard Junior Henry A. Chapman and Henry A. Ballis.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Holland three hundred dollars to purchase wood for the Government.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Aemy Jump, one hundred and seventy five dollars in part of his account for collecting and delivering to the Armourer at Easton four hundred and thirty Muskets &c. as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Pindell sixty four dollars in part of his account for collecting and delivering to the Armourer at Annapolis one hundred and eighty three Muskets &c. as per account passed and filed.

The Account of Colonel Richard Waters for collecting Muskets &c. was passed for one thousand and seventy three dollars and twenty five cents, leaving a balance of seventy three dollars and twenty five cents due him after deducting one thousand dollars that had heretofore been advanced to him which balance cannot be paid without the provision of the Legislature, as the fund out of which the Agents are to be compensated is exhausted.
