

Saturday January 8. 1820

The Honourable James Bulcher appeared in the Council Room and qualified before James Hunter Esquire, a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County by taking the several oaths required by the Constitution and Form of Government and laws of this State, as also by taking and subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion as also by taking an oath to support the Laws and Constitution of the United States.

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Hon^{ble} James A. Stabb James Bulcher, Grafton Duwall, John Stephen and Thomas H. Wilkinson.

Mr Henry Thompson was on the nomination of His Excellency the Governor appointed Messenger of the Council and immediately qualified before James Hunter Esquire a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County.

Moses Orme, James Williamson and Roger D. Baldwin were on the nomination of His Excellency the Governor appointed additional Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County.
