

Coroner for Queen Anne's County Thomas Crane.,

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr James Holland seventy one dollars and sixty eight and a half cents for salary as messenger of the Council up to the eighth of January Instant as per account passed and filed.

On the joint recommendation of both Houses of the Legislature a Commission issued to Walter Smith as Register of Wills for Calvert County vice Joseph Wilkinson resigned.,

By the Petition of Enos Schell and George Adams of Charles County accompanied by a transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County, it appears, that they entered into a recognizance in the sum of fifty pounds each for the appearance of a certain James Bevan at the said Court at March Term eighteen hundred and eighteen to answer a Presentment and so forth. The Petitioners state that the said James Bevan did not make his appearance agreeably to the tenor of the Recognizance notwithstanding the great exertions that were made use of by the Petitioners to cause him to do so.

The Board do order and direct that twenty five pounds in each case be remitted agreeably to the recommendation of the said Court.,
